HOW TO.... SUBMIT ENTRIES ONLINE.

Many of us are hesitant when it comes to submitting artwork online. We may be worried that it won't "go through" or we passed the deadline trying. Some of us may have trouble attaching and sending nice photos of our work. There are a number of issues that can arise without the knowledge of properly sending a submission digitally.

In some instances, we have no choice but to use the computer or we may forfeit a grand opportunity to showcase our work. Gallery directors don't waste time with physical appointments anymore. It's much easier for them to view your entries at their own convenience- any time, day or night. Many submissions are shown to a panel of judges through digital media on a large screen.

Not computer saavy, you say?

This presentation is going to help you take the stress out of submitting entries online for juried shows, gallery representation and/or any other digitally-based art submissions.

Leslie Danklefs, BCAG Exhibitions Coordinator is going to demonstrate how to submit images of your work to a venue that requires electronic (or digital) submission of entries. She will also discuss the various ways you can save images and suggest different methods for organizing your electronic files of images.
