Demo: Scott Rawlins to talk about and demo botanical illustration.

Scott Rawlins is a scientific illustrator, naturalist and museum educator who has been teaching scientific illustration at Arcadia University since 1994. He holds degrees from Earlham College (biology), the George Washington University (museum education) and the University of Michigan (medical & biological illustration). A strong proponent of study abroad, Scott has traveled to five continents collecting specimens to draw and study. He has served on the board of the American Society of Botanical Artists, the Philadelphia Society of Botanical Illustrators and the Guild of Natural Science Illustrators. Scott's illustrations have appeared in numerous books, including Your Inner Fish and Shackelford's Surgery of the Alimentary Tract. Journals that have published his illustrations are Acta Zoologica, Records of the Australian Museum, Harvard's Bulletin of the Museum of Comparative Zoology, Geobios and Zootaxa. Scott plans to retire from teaching in May 2020 so that he can devote more time to relearning the piano, studying a Romance language and honing his digital drawing skills.
